1 Scope

This policy is applicable to all Eltronic Group-related companies. If a company stipulates a policy in compliance with separate law & regulations or otherwise detached policies, this policy can be denied.

2 Basis

Basis of this policy is ISO 9001:2015 - ISO 14001:2015 – ISO 45001:2018 and national law and international law.

3 Purpose

This policy is aimed to uphold the minimum compliance with the HLS ISO standards and is to be assimilated by companies in regard to management systems and certificates.

4 Targets

Eltronic Group and its subsidiaries are expected to comply with this policy and are requested to formulate targets for this.

5 Ownership

This policy is owned and governed by QHSE Director or higher-level management within the company.

6 Evaluation

The policy must be evaluated at least once a year in compliance with request in ISO HLS Standards. An evaluation must also be performed, if there is planned or has been sever changes in organization and/or in strategy.

7 Policy

It is the policy of the group that we always conduct our procurement activities with integrity, thus we select suppliers which adhere to our ethical objectives, and support the principles in our ESG group policies.

We will act with due diligence in managing risks in our procurement procedures and support do-no-significant harm principles on all ESG-related aspects.

We will act with transparency and work together with our suppliers on improving any challenges and issues.

7.1 Policy Statements

We will live up to our policy by:

Ensuring a supplier code of conduct that enforces compliance with the UN Global Compacts ten principles, UN guiding principles, and OECD guidelines for multinational companies

Communicating on challenges in our supply chain and actively mitigating risks.

7.2 Group Targets

1. All high-risk suppliers, defined by each Subsidiaries themselves, to have signed the Group supplier code of conduct and NDA by 2023
